Dear Families,

I am writing to inform you that the school's computer network has been compromised by an unknown person or persons. This unlawful activity has been reported to the police who are investigating.

At this stage, we do not know if those responsible have been able to access any data, or provided it to anyone else, however we encourage you to take precautions and to be alert if you notice anything unusual.

What type of data is stored on the school's network?

The information that you provided when you enrolled your child at the school. This is called personal and sensitive information and includes things such as:

Your child's name, your name, your address, date of birth, religion
Medicare number, Tax File Number, Centrelink number
Bank account details

For some families, the following may also be relevant for your child:

Medical conditions, medical reports, student behaviour plans
Parenting Plans, Custody notes
Passport, Visa

There may be other information that is relevant, such as the name and contact details of anyone who you have listed as emergency contacts.

What should we do?

Contact your bank and explain what has happened
Check your bank transactions carefully
Contact your bank straight away if you notice anything unusual
Tell the people who you listed as an emergency contact

Who will the school notify?

Australian Taxation Office, Centrelink, Medicare, Australian Passport Office
Police
Catholic Education Melbourne
Office of the Australian Information Commissioner
Any other organisations which the school thinks need to be informed

The school is working with the police and Catholic Education Melbourne which is assisting. Please be reassured that we will notify you if we become aware of any additional information that would be helpful.

I apologise for any inconvenience or concern that has been caused and appreciate the support of the school community. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me.

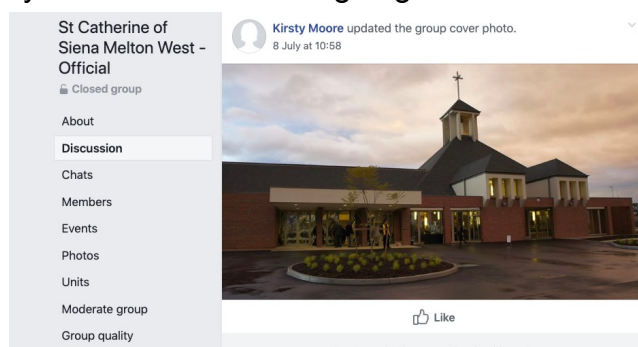
