Dear Parents and Guardians

For many years now we have been without a statue of St Catherine of Siena. The small one we previously had disappeared several years ago from the church grounds and has not been able to be located. To rectify this we have commissioned Timothy Schmaltz to create a statue of St Catherine of Siena for us. Timothy created the beautiful statue of the Homeless Jesus which is installed outside the church. The statue he is creating for us is based on The Dialogue, the book of teachings St Catherine wrote, and will have St Catherine and tableaus representing some of the ideas and teachings from this text. Recently Timothy sent us some photos of the work to date on this commission. Once completed this statue will be installed in the roundabout between the school and church.

Getting children to talk about their feelings can be hard sometimes.

Canteen Update

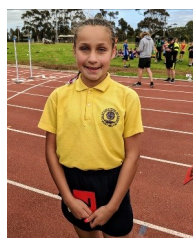
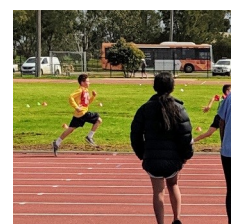
The last day for lunch orders and over the counter sales this term will be Thursday, 19th September. The canteen will be **CLOSED** on Friday, 20th September.

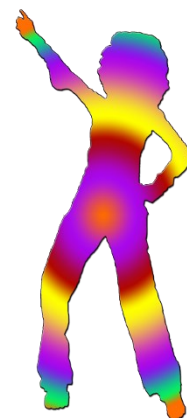
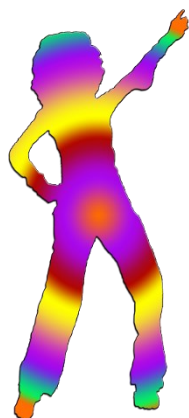

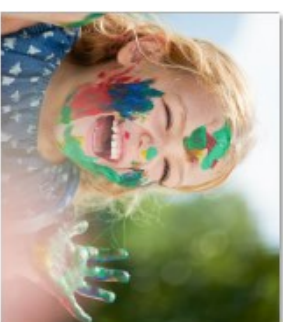
