God's eye to look before me, God's ear to hear me,


God's word to speak for me, God's hand to guard me,

Next week our Year 3 - Year 6 children return to school and so for many families a "normal" routine can once again come into play for you all. At this time we are still asking all families to drop children at external gates as restrictions still limit access to the school to essential personnel only. We will have additional staff available in case any children find walking in without parents and carers a bit too challenging. As there will be no canteen for the remainder of Term 2, please make sure your child has snack and lunch as well as a water bottle as the drink taps are unavailable until further notice.

In Term 1 our Year 3 children prepared to Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation however due to COVID 19 we were unable to hold these liturgies. Parents and carers of Year 3 children will be contacted with the arrangements we have made in collaboration with Fr Michael for these liturgies which will take place early in Term 3. While we are able to hold these liturgies so the children can receive this Sacrament, the current restrictions will mean that parents and family members will be unable to be present. I know that this will be a huge disappointment to you as you would love nothing more than to be there with your child, however at this time we cannot accommodate that wish.

A reminder to all parents that children with SURNAMES beginning with A - K will be dismissed at 3pm while those with SURNAMES L - Z will be dismissed at 3:15pm. This is to limit the number of adults gathering at gates in the afternoon so we ask you all to adhere to social distancing protocols. Entry in the afternoon is through GATE 1 only and we ask you to Exit through GATE 2 so we have a single flow of traffic. So your child knows which gate to be picked up from we have given them all a key tag; please make sure the number of the gate you will be picking them up from is clearly written on the tag and we will ensure they are at the correct gate for pick up. Drop off in the morning will continue as it has been, with children dropped at one of the 4 external gates and no parent/family access.

We may need to refine these procedures so we ask for your continued support and patience as we work to keep everyone safe during this time.

If you are bringing your child to school late or picking them up early please make your way to the gate outside the hall toilets and call the school office on 9743 2166 so a staff member can open the gate.

Returning to School for year 3 - 6

Children in Years 3 - 6 will return to school on Tuesday 9th June.

Any children in these years who were at school for the last 7 weeks can continue to participate in Remote Learning at school until the 9th June. These children will be in their classroom **supervised** by their teacher.

Children whose parents have now returned to work and who have no one to supervise them at home can also return to school early. Please contact me to discuss your situation in this case.

Children considered vulnerable can also return to school prior to the 9th June. Please contact me to discuss your situation in this case.

IMPORTANT DATES

- *Monday 8th June PUBLIC HOLIDAY
- *Tuesday 9th June Year 3 Year 6 return to school
- Any children in Year 3 Year 6 whose parents choose not to send them back to school will NOT have the opportunity for Remote Learning from the Friday 5th June. This was only ever for the time children could not be at school so once they return teachers will be teaching face to face. Children still at home will now be classed as absent from school.
- *Sanitiser is available in all classrooms and offices so every child/staff member entering a space throughout the day,/returning from the bathroom will need to use this.
- *At this stage children are **not able** to bring their own sport/play equipment to school. We will have a supply of equipment they can use at break times and we have a process for cleaning this after use.
- *Access to the school for parents and visitors will be limited to essential visits only and all visitors will need to complete safety measures prior to entering. At this stage there will be **NO school canteen** until further notice.

Cleaning

We have engaged our cleaner to come in in the middle of the day to clean the toilets and outside quiet area seating after recess and to have this completed prior to the children go out at lunchtime. These will be cleaned again towards the end of the day. This cleaning is in addition to all regular cleaning and will continue for the foreseeable future. All classrooms have a supply of cleaning materials so that staff can clean tables throughout the day. They also have antibacterial wipes so that high touch items such as door handles can be cleaned throughout the day also.

Phone Calls

During this time of Remote Learning staff have had many occasions where they have had to contact parents by phone while they have been working from home. In most cases this was with their number blocked and we appreciate parents answering these calls so that we could speak to you and support your child. Sometimes staff have forgotten to hide their number and so parents and carers have access to staff private mobile numbers. If this is the case I ask that you honour the privacy of that staff member and not use this number to contact them.

Reports

We hope to get Semester 1 school reports out to parents and carers by the end of this term. However with the staggered return to school we will only have all children back from the 9th June, which is only a few weeks prior to the end of term, so reports <u>may</u> need to be pushed out to the beginning of Term 3. These reports will not be as comprehensive as they have been in the past due to the transition to Remote Learning in Term 2. Our focus will be on giving you a report which comments on your child's achievements in Religious Education, English and Mathematics in Term 1, a summary of the content covered in these 3 areas throughout Term 2 and a comment on your child's mindset and engagement in Remote Learning throughout Term 2. A more detailed explanation of the report and the reasons for these changes will come out with the report.

Drop Off and Pick Up Areas

Semester 1 Reports

Semester 1 Reports will be released online via the nForma Parent Portal on Thursday, 25th June.

Instructions on how to access the nForma Parent Portal will be sent out to all new families to the email addresses that have been previously supplied to the school.

It is very important that you have updated your email address with the school, as an automated email containing instructions and login details will come from noreply@nforma.com.au and not the school. Please ensure that you check your junk/spam folder for an email from that address.

It is highly recommended that you use a computer to access your child's reports for the first time. Subsequent logins can be made on a mobile device if preferred.

Once you have followed the instructions, you will be able to view your child's report online. You can also use the following link: https://parent.nforma.ct.com.au/app/index.html? schooldomain=scmeltonwest#/login

Once in the portal you will need to select your child's name (if you have more than one at our school) and then choose 'Assessment and Reporting'. Then select the year/semester.

It is important to remember your username and password for future logins.

Please note that your new password needs to be at least 7 characters long and must include at least one non alpha-numeric character, e.g. *, - / or similar.
