Dear Parents & Guardians.

The end of the year is fast approaching and is always a busy time for us all, it is important to remember in all of this, that at this time we also live in the Season of Advent and are preparing for Christmas. Sunday 29th November will be the first Sunday of Advent, a time when we remember that journey to Christmas so long ago and reflect on what it means for us in this present day, at this present time and maybe, especially this year, what it means for us now, after the year we have all had. Usually we would come together as a school community to reflect on these messages, this is not possible this year but we will be sharing a slide show and viewing this simultaneously across the school.

The class structure for the following year is greatly determined by enrolment numbers for each year level as well as the level of funding we receive. Although our enrolment numbers for 2021 are not final and applications are still being received; we have been able to finalise a structure for 2021 which still allows for this growth. In 2021 we will have:

Children will find out which class they are in and which teacher they have on our transition day at the end of the year. Specialist classes for 2021 will remain the same as they were this year with all classes receiving 1 hour of each specialist class per week.

It is surprising how quickly we have come to the end of the year, so that accounts can be finalised I ask all families to ensure that they are up to date with the payment of fees. For those families who are finding this difficult due to the unusual circumstances we have had this year please make a time to speak to me so that we can assist you with this prior to the end of the year and so that this issue is not carried forward into 2021.






