# **COVID 19 School Restrictions Update**

With the recent announcements by the Premier and the continued "0" days we have had, there has been another easing of restrictions in schools and we welcome a return to a more normal school routine. Some of these restrictions, while lifted, are either too late for us to implement or require the organisation of trades, such as plumbers reinstating the drink taps, so are listed below in the "But Not Now" section. The table below is a summary of these changes.

The main one is that all children will be dismissed at 3:15pm and all 4 exit points will be available. Parents and guardians will be able to enter the school grounds, should you choose to do so, to drop your child off and pick them up and to see your child's teacher. Consider the independence your children have gained in walking in themselves each day when thinking about this.


