#### Dear families,

There have been some children arriving at school well before staff are on duty and waiting at gates in the park without supervision. Staff commence morning duty at 8:30am and children should not be dropped off prior to this time. If you do need to leave children early we ask that you leave them with family or friends or alternatively use OSHClub so that they can be properly supervised. Other students are arriving after the bell has gone. These children miss out on the opportunity to play with peers prior to the bell and also miss out on the important beginning of the day with their class. For some children, walking in late and being the centre of attention is not a positive start to the day. I ask that all parents and careers consider morning arrangements so that children arrive at school at an appropriate time.

At the end of this term we will be holding Parent Teacher Interviews. These are an important opportunity for all parents and carers to discuss your child's progress to date and also plan ways of supporting their learning over the coming term.
