Dear Families,

Teachers are currently in the process of preparing the semester reports which will be available to you on Friday, 18th June. These reports are a reflection of your child's progress throughout Term 1 and Term 2 and indicate their achievements across all areas of learning. The first page is for Religious Education and gives you an overview of the units covered, your child's level of achievement and an indication of the skills and behaviours they showed within this area of learning. The other curriculum areas are reported on in the same way and your child's attendance history is also listed for you.

You will all have access to your child's report through an online portal where you will be able to read your child's report at a time convenient to you. Once you have accessed the report you will be able to print it should you wish to do so or save it as a PDF file. It is important to keep a copy of this report as you may be asked for a copy of it when enrolling your child in secondary school or another school setting if you move away from Melton. Instructions for how to access the portal will be sent to you shortly.

A reminder to parents that although we do not have formal parent teacher interviews this term, if you have any queries or questions regarding your child's progress or interactions at school please make a time to see your child's teacher so that these can be attended to as soon as possible and a plan for future actions, if required, put in place. If you already have a plan in place to support your child's learning or social interactions it may be appropriate to organise another conversation prior to the end of term to check progress on this.

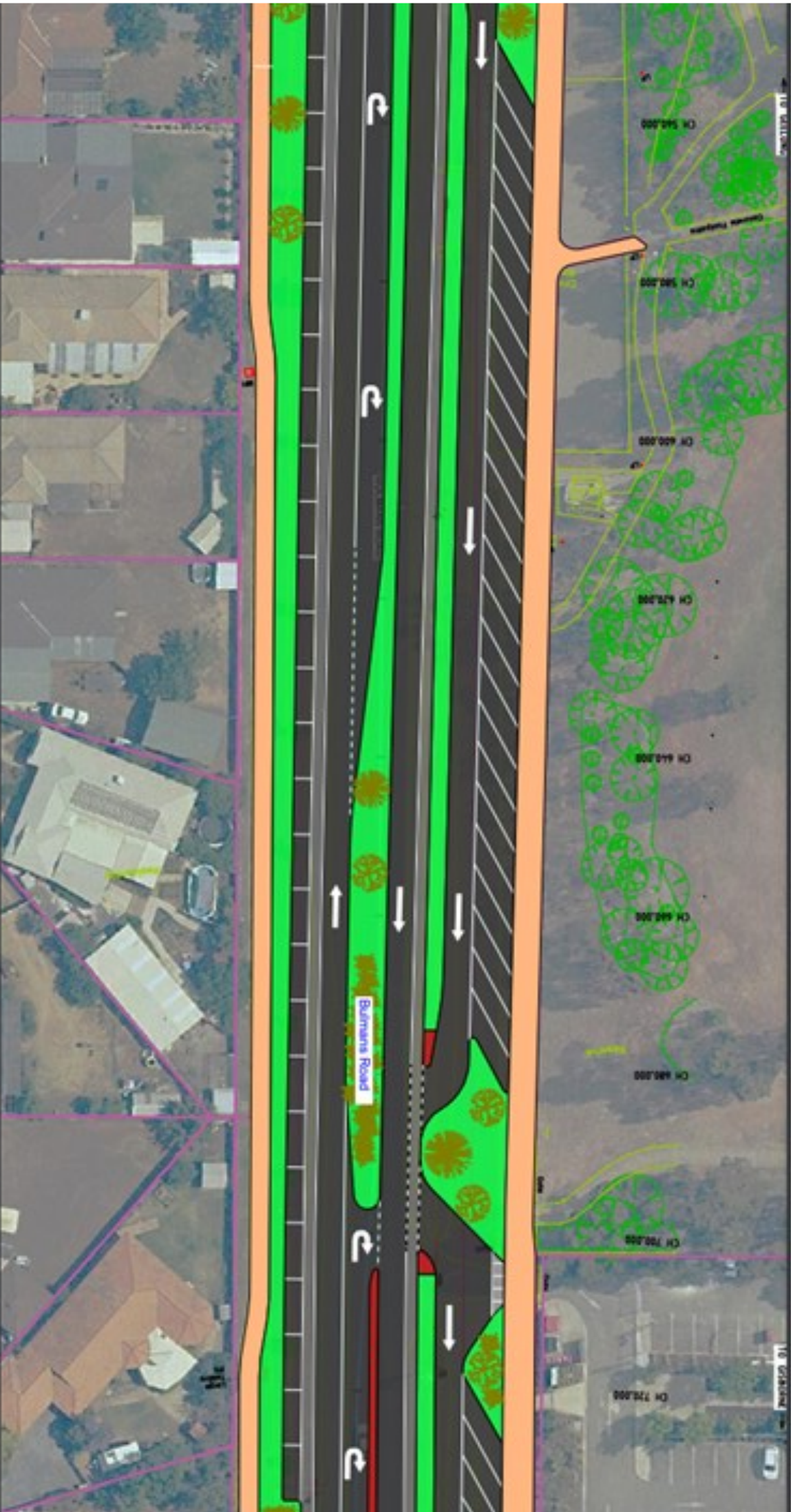
