Next week is National Refugee Week during which we are all called to pray for those who have no place to call home. Timothy Schmaltz created the statue pictured here, which sits in St Peter's Square in Rome, to commemorate the travels and hopes of displaced people through human history. It is called *Angels Unawares*, after a line from Hebrews which says; "Be welcoming to strangers, many have entertained angels unawares." Among those represented are Mary, Joseph and Jesus fleeing to Egypt, Irish, Chinese, Vietnamese, Syrian, African, immigrants fleeing homelands across the years.

Dear Families,

On Wednesday we heard from Anthony Merlino, the Acting Premier, that restrictions will ease as of 11:59pm this evening (Thursday 10th June). The implications of the lifting of these restrictions for schools are as follows -

*all primary school children will return to onsite school on Friday, 11th June

*there will be no Remote Learning on SEESAW from Thursday night

*normal classes and school times will resume on Friday, 11th June

*children are not required to wear a mask but may do so if they, or you wish them to

*the canteen will be open and available on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays as usual

*staff will wear masks when inside unless they have an exemption or are in the act of teaching in which case a mask is not mandated

*at this time the only visitors to school will be essential contractors and parents who require essential assistance or information from office staff

*Prep 2022 Interviews will be rescheduled for Term 3; we will advertise these dates once they have been confirmed

To celebrate the return to school children can wear casual clothes on Friday as they settle back into school. We will take the time on Friday to ensure that the children reconnect with friends and staff and that they have the opportunity to talk about their experiences of learning at home and then turn their attention back to re-establishing the routines needed for effective learning at school.

At this stage I am unable to confirm whether or not the Year 4 First Communions scheduled for the 19th June will be able to go ahead. From Friday, 11th June Religious Ceremonies are capped at 50 people; it is hoped that a further easing of restrictions next week may allow more people to be in attendance. As soon as we have this information I will convey this to you all.
