We need to make sure we are taking care of ourselves also so that we can take care of others. Dear Families.

This week we have sent out letters to many families about fee arrangements. So that all families have the same information I am including a summary of the letters here for you all.

Earlier this year Melbourne Archdiocese of Catholic schools (MACS) developed a Concessional Fee Policy for all MACS schools. This policy states that anyone who meets the eligibility criteria and is on a CentrePay or Direct Debit plan may be eligible for a rebate off their school fees and curriculum levy. Other changes such as swimming and camp are not covered in the concession. The eligibility criteria are:

- •any family of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander heritage.
- •any family holding an HCC and eligible for CSEF.
- •any family experiencing severe financial hardship.
- •any family holding a DVA Gold Card.
- •any family identified as refugees and holding an ImmiCard.

If you believe that you fit into any of these categories and wish to apply for a fee concession please call the office to make a time to discuss your situation with me. Please note that to continue to receive the fee concession you must always have a Direct Debit or CentrePay in place. Cancelling these at any time may jeopardise receiving the concession in following years.

If you requite onsite supervision for the coming week of remote learning please return the form emailed to all families today by Saturday afternoon so that I can organise adequate staff coverage for supervision.




Get ready! Book Week will soon be here.


