Dear Families,

Welcome back to term 4!! I hope you were all able to have some downtime over the recent school holidays and spend some time relaxing.

During the holidays announcements were made by the Premier Daniel Andrews regarding the return to school for children over the coming weeks. This will be a staggered start and may still change so we will need to be flexible. As things stand at the moment the following applies -

Week beg.11th Oct. - Remote Learning still in place with only children of essential workers or vulnerable children onsite

Week beg.18th Oct. - ALL Preps at school Mon, Tues and Wed and then Remote Learning or onsite supervision Thurs and Fri.

- Year 1 & 2 children Remote Learning or onsite supervision Mon - Wed then ALL at school Thurs & Fri

Week beg. 25th Oct.- ALL Preps at school Mon, Tues and Wed and then Remote Learning or onsite supervision Thurs and Fri.

- Year 1 & 2 children Remote Learning or onsite supervision Mon Wed then ALL at school Thurs & Fri
- Year 3 & 4 Remote Learning or onsite supervision Mon, Thurs & Fri then ALL at school Tues & Wed
- Year 5 & 6 children Remote Learning or onsite supervision Mon Wed then ALL at school Thurs & Fri

Week beg. 1st Nov - Monday = School Closure Day,

- Tuesday = Public Holiday.
- Wednesday = ALL Prep, Year 3 & 4 at school ALL others Remote Learning or onsite supervision
- Thursday = ALL Year 1,2,5,6 at school ALL others Remote Learning or onsite supervision
- Friday = ALL years levels at school, no Remote Learning or activities posted on Seesaw.

Week beg. 8th Nov - ALL year levels back at school 5 days a week for the remainder of the term

While the staggered return to school is in place specialist classes will be posted online according to the following schedule. Once ALL year levels are back at school we will have our regular specialist schedule back in place. The regular schedule will be posted in the newsletter in week 4 & 5 to remind you of your child's specialist days.

Specialist Classes in Week 3 = Year 1 & 2 on Wednesday, Year Prep, 3,4,5 & 6 on Friday Specialist Classes in Week 4 = Year 1, 2, 5 & 6 on Wednesday, Year Prep, 3, & 4 on Friday
