We are pleased to announce that the Year 6 Confirmation and the Year 4 First Eucharist have been rescheduled to the following dates.

#### Please note the following restrictions apply:

Victorian Restrictions apply when gathering as a community in the Church. As per Government Guidelines, all those who attend a mass at the Church must be fully vaccinated. A staff member will be present asking for your digital COVID vaccine certificate at the entrance. You will be required to check in using the QR code provided.

We are anticipating at this stage that 150 people will be allowed at each ceremony. This would be the candidate + 3 vaccinated family members who are 16 and above.
