Dear Families.

On the 24th & 25th November the children in Year 4, will receive Communion for the first time. This is a very special time. not only for the children, but also for their families. They have waited for this day and there were times that we thought we might not be able to celebrate this very special Sacrament this year! Shortly before Jesus died, He had a farewell meal with His friends. He told stories that gave them hope for new life. He broke bread that gave them new life, by sharing Himself along with the bread. He asked them to remember Him in this way. When we come to Mass we remember, with thanks, who Jesus was and we believe, and know, that He is still with us. At Mass, we recognise Jesus' presence in the people, in Fr
