Dear Parents,

Australian Government

I am reaching out prior to the end of first term to encourage and remind you Operation COVID Shield all to book a COVID-19 vaccination for your child.

Over 50 per cent of all children aged 5 to 11 have now received a first dose, with many now due for a second dose (eight weeks after the first). In particular as we approach school holidays and the weather cools down, it is important to take steps to minimise the impact of COVID-19. Vaccines are a safe and effective way to protect your child, and the community.

The Department of Health website provides a number of resources with further information about seeking COVID-19 vaccination. Attached is a Fact Sheet which you could use to have a conversation with your child. Term 2 begins -Tuesday, 26th April

Dear Parents and carers,

As Term 1 draws to a close I would like to notify you of some changes for Term 2. The children have settled in well this year and are excited being back at school with friends, however we acknowledge that parents and carers have missed out on so much over the past few years as well as the start to this year. Schools are vibrant places and based in community so need the contributions of all community members to really come alive. With this in mind please note the following changes...

*parents and carers can come into the yard at the beginning of the day to drop children off. The children have developed their independence in doing this for themselves to date so allowing them to carry their bag and come in by themselves sometimes is an important skill to foster. GATES 1, 2 & 4 WILL ALL BE OPEN IN THE MORNING.

*parents and carers can come into the yard at the end of the day to pick children up. GATES 1, 2, 3 & 4 WILL ALL BE OPEN IN THE AFTERNOON FOR ENTRY AND EXIT.

*we will be running parent helper training sessions for any parents and carers who wish to help in classes. All parent helpers MUST have a Working With Children's Check, be doubly vaccinated and wear a mask whilst inside the school buildings.

*meetings with teachers can be face to face as long as masks are worn when inside and all visitors are vaccinated. I appreciate your cooperation with this Government and Health Department requirement for Primary School visitors.

*masks do not need to be worn outside in the school yard but you can do so if you wish.

*excursions will be occurring at various stages throughout the year. If you wish to assist please make sure you have a current Working With Children's Check. Depending on the venue vaccination may also be required.

*we are hoping to invite family members to many of the school events we would normally celebrate with you. Events such as Book Week, the Art Show, Grandparents and Significant Family Members Day. This will depend on the COVID situation at the time but we will do our best to have you with us.

The map included shows the school and the 4 main entry points for your reference.
