Semester 1 student reports will be available online via the nForma Parent Portal today, Friday, 17th June.

Instructions on how to access the nForma Parent Portal and temporary passwords have been sent out to **ALL** families to the email addresses that have been supplied to the school.

**It is very important that you have updated your email address with the school**, as an automated email containing instructions and login details will come from [noreply@nforma.com.au](mailto:noreply@nforma.com.au) and not the school. Please ensure that you check your junk/spam folder for an email from that address.

It is highly recommended that you use a computer to access your child's reports for the first time. Subsequent logins can be made on a mobile device if preferred.

Once in the portal you will need to select your child's name (if you have more than one at our school) and then choose 'Assessment and Reporting'. Then select the year/semester.

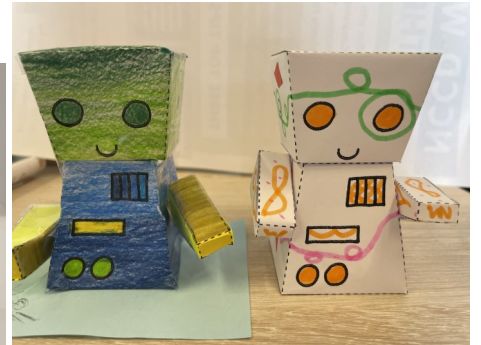

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## Town Squared

For the past 12 months, the Maths Association of Victoria has been working with educational game developers Playlunch Games on the development of Town Squared. Town Squared is a game-based platform for children aged 7 - 11 that builds confidence and reduces maths anxiety in children and families.

In Town Squared, children are immersed in a beautiful multiplayer world that weaves maths concepts and financial literacy learning into gameplay. The aim is to get children to apply their classroom learning when they get home, by playing interesting scenarios in a collaborative and encouraging environment with their friends.

The game also provides families with access to a Family Portal, with resources including articles by MAV that explain maths concepts, and home activities to encourage children's interests and maths skills.

During the pilot phase of this game it is free for the remainder of 2022. Tap on the image below for a link to the website.

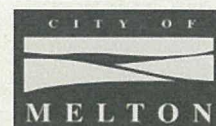

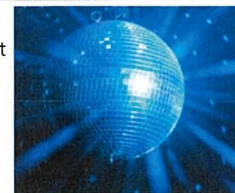
