Bulmans Road Update

I know the challenges that those of you who drive your children to school have with the parking infront of the school. The update on the upgrade to Bulmans Road is Stage 1A between Sovereign Blvd and Centenary Ave - Anticipated construction timeframes are April/May till June 2023. Stage 1B between Sovereign Blvd and the boundary of Arthur Westlake Reserve (School frontage) -Anticipated construction timeframes between June 2023 till August 2023. Council will try and deliver the bulk of Stage 1B works in the school holiday period to minimise traffic disruption. Stage 1C between the boundary of Arthur Westlake Reserve to Westlake Drive - Anticipated construction timeframes between August till October 2023.

(Hint: you may not be able to see all the feet)


How many fishing rods?
