Please keep these dates free as we would love to see all students at families attend this event.




Roll Up! Roll Up!

We have been focussing on Poetry in our Literacy Classes and this competition provides students with the opportunity to share their knowledge and creativity.


Students have two weeks to prepare their entry. They can enter with a hard copy or electronic copy. Your poem could be in any form you like and there will be prizes!
