Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Carers,

Next Friday is Remembrance Day. On the 11th of November at venues all across our land, we remember that others laid down their lives so that we might be able to live with the freedom that we now enjoy. We remember the end of the first World War on 11th November 1918 when the guns fell silent and four years of fighting ended. Every year, on 11th November at 11am – the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month – we stop to remember service personnel who have died or suffered, not only in the First World War but in all other wars, conflicts and peace operations since the beginning of the 20th century. Next Friday we will hold a Remembrance Day liturgy commencing at 10:45am and ending with a minutes silence at 11:00am. Our senior leaders will represent the school in the ceremony at the Cenotaph conducted by the Melton branch of the RSL and lay a wreath on our behalf.

Our Prep 2023 Orientation sessions commence next Tuesday, these will be held over the next 3 weeks and are an opportunity for the children to become a little familiar with the school prior to commencing next year and to meet their teacher prior to 2023. Information is also provided to parents about their child's transition from kindergarten to school so it is important that you attend these sessions.

A reminder to all families of the school closure day on Monday, 5th December. This day has been previously advertised and will be a 2023 planning day for all staff so there will be no school for children on this day.

An additional closure day will be Monday 19th December. This day would have been the last day for children with an early 1:30pm finish but will now be a school closure day. The last day of the 2022 school year for children will now be Friday the 16th December. This will be a normal day and children will be dismissed at 3:15pm.

Expressions of Interest - Free English Language Lessons

Djerriwarrh, Community and Education Services Melton offer an Adult Migrant English Program (AMEP). The AMEP is available to migrants and humanitarian entrants aged 18 years and

over. This includes all permanent visa holders, some temporary visa holders and citizens who previously held an eligible visa. These sessions are held at their offices in Melton.

However we are now taking expressions of interest from parents who would like to participate in free language lessons to be held at our school during school time.

This program is being trialed at St. Anthony's Melton this term. If we have enough interest from parents we may be able to start a program at school in 2023.
