Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Carers,

Next Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. We often think of Lent as a time of fasting and in many ways it is. One way of thinking about this is fasting and feasting. Fasting from those things which hurt, harm and marginalise and feasting on those things which repair, energise, engage and enliven. The text beside is from Pope Francis, calling each of us to consider what we might fast or feast on this Lent.

Do You Want To Fast This Len? In the words of Pope Francis • Fast from hurting words • Fast from sedness • Fast from anger • Fast from nessimism • Fast from worries • Fast from pressures • Fast from bitterness • Fast from selfishness • Fast from grudges • Fast from words

At the beginning of next term our Year 3 children will make their First Reconciliation in the Sacrament of Penance. These liturgies will be held on the 2nd, 3rd & 4th of May at 7pm. In preparation for this our Year 3 children will be presented to the Parish at Masses on Saturday the 11th and Sunday 12th of March where they will be formally enrolled in the Preparation for this Sacrament. Please note these dates if your child is in Year 3 or in Year 4, 5 or 6 and has not received this Sacrament and wishes to do so this year.

Each year students in Year 3 & 5 sit the NAPLAN assessments. These online assessments are conducted over a 2 week period from the 14th to the 23rd March in the areas of Reading, Writing and Numeracy. They are conducted in all schools across Australia with the expectation that all children sit these unless they have a valid exemption or are withdrawn at a parent's request. Any child who has an exemption or is withdrawn must have a form filled in by the school and signed by the parent. If you think your child should be exempt or withdrawn please see the valid reasons below and then make a time to discuss this with me.

• Valid Exemptions are - Students with a language background other than English who have arrived from overseas and have been attending school for less than a year before the test may be exempted OR

Students with significant intellectual disability and/or those with significant co-existing conditions which severely limit their capacity to participate in the tests may be exempted from sitting the national tests.

• Reasons for Withdrawal - students may be withdrawn from the testing program by their parent/carer for reasons such as religious beliefs or philosophical objections to testing.

On the 23rd and 24th of March the school will be closed as all staff will be attending a 2 day staff conference offsite. This will be an important professional development opportunity for all staff so I ask that you make a note of these school closure days



NAPLAN 2023

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) for Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 students are now held in March each year. In 2023, the NAPLAN test window is between Wednesday 15 March and Monday 27 March.

NAPLAN tests assess student knowledge and skills in writing, reading, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy.

The results of the tests provide information for students, parents, teachers and principals and can be used to improve student achievement.

Last year was the first time the NAPLAN tests were delivered in an online format. This year all tests will be online except for Year 3 Writing which will be written on paper.

A public demonstration site is available for schools, teachers, parents, carers and students to familiarise themselves with the online tests. Students will also be completing trial tests at school before the actual test.

All eligible students are expected to participate in the NAPLAN tests. Support can be arranged for students with disabilities, if the student regularly uses similar support for classroom assessment tasks. Some students may be exempt from the test and parental consent is required before any support due to disability or exemption is granted.
