## Principal's Message

Over the first few weeks of school office staff have called parents and carers when a child is marked as absent for an unknown reason. It is important that all absences are checked and that children are where they are meant to be. If your child is going to be away please send your child's teacher a Seesaw message or email or alert the school with a phone call or Skoolbag message. In this way the absence can be coded correctly and you will not receive any unnecessary calls.

There have been some children arriving at school well before staff are on duty and waiting at the gate at the front of the school without supervision. Staff commence morning duty at 8:30am and children should not be dropped off prior to this time. If you do need to leave children early we ask that you leave them with family or friends or alternatively use OSHClub so that they can be properly supervised. Additionally, many children are arriving after the bell has gone – some days in excess of 30 children. These children miss the opportunity to play with peers prior to the bell and also miss out on the important morning routine with their class. For some children, walking in late and being the centre of attention is not a positive start to the day. I ask that all parents and careers consider morning arrangements so that children arrive at school at an appropriate time and can start the day with their peers.

At the end of this term we will be holding Parent Teacher Interviews. These are an important opportunity for all parents and carers to discuss your child's progress to date and also plan ways of supporting their learning over the coming term. Information on how to book an interview time via the online portal will be sent out to all families shortly, however I ask that you keep Thursday, 30th March free for this meeting. Children will be dismissed at 1:00pm on this day and interviews will begin at 1:30pm. Interviews will also be held on Monday 27th, Tuesday 28th and Wednesday 29th March between 8:00 and 8:30am.

On Monday, 6th March Easter raffle tickets will be sent out to all families. On Monday, 6th March the children are able to come to school in casual clothes and bring an Easter egg donation as a contribution to the Easter Raffle prizes. This raffle has been organised by our Parents and Friends group and is our first fund raising activity for the year. We ask that all families support this raffle if they can and see if they can sell these tickets to family and friends. More tickets can be obtained from the office if needed. This raffle will be drawn on Monday, 3rd April. Thanks in advance for your support and Good Luck!!
