## Swimming Program

Students at St. Catherine of Siena Primary School are participating in swimming lessons at Melton Swim School. These sessions go for 30 minutes and involve stroke development and water safety components. The swimming program is held in accordance with the Victorian Curriculum and Health & Physical Education guidelines on swimming and water safety for students. It states, that students should be working towards completion of the Victorian Water Safety certificate by the end of year 6. The certificate describes a range of competencies that focus on: water safety knowledge, rescue skills, survival sequences and swimming ability. This is part of the curriculum and it is an expectation all students participate and **permission is required by parents/guardians**. The 8 lessons will be held over a 2 week period.

There will be Dinka, Arabic and Burmese interpreters (various dialects) available on-site to help families.
