



What's inclusive of the School Fees?

The annual school fees at St Catherine of Siena Primary School include all excursions, incursions, personal learning devices, stationery, camps and administration costs. School photos and school uniforms will be at an additional cost to you. Please advise us if you have a current healthcare card, pension card or immigration card, as this could further reduce the cost of your school fees.

School Fees Pack

All school fees are due by **10th March 2025** unless a payment plan has been arranged with the School Bursar.

School fees are determined annually by the MACS Board. Fees generally increase with the EPI (Education Price Index), which is approximately 3-4% per annum.

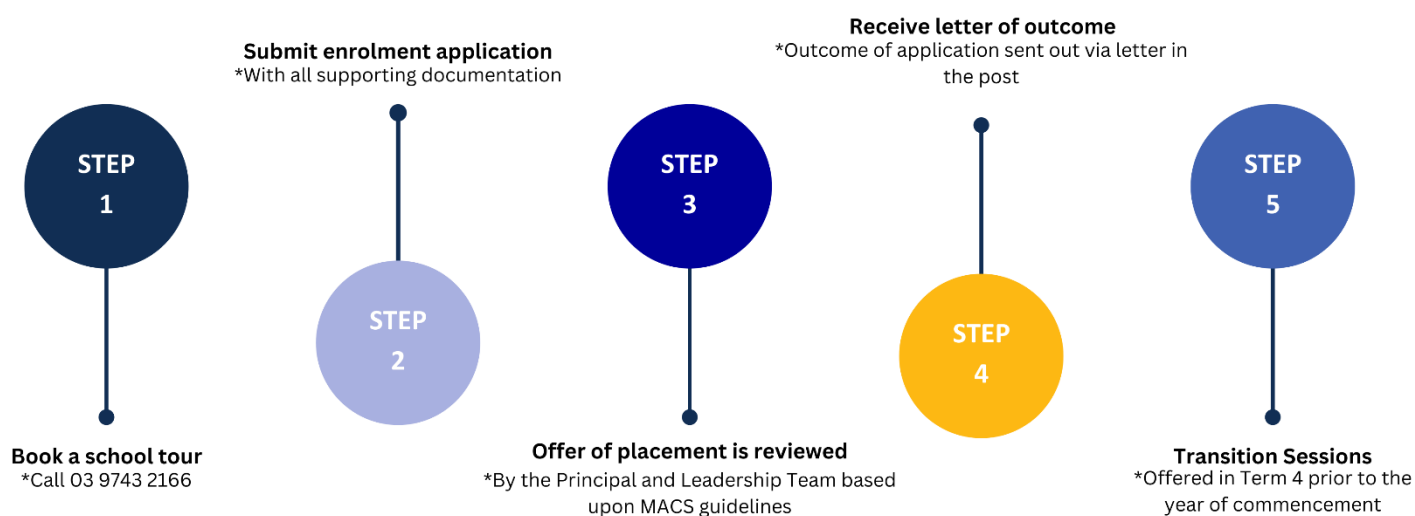

Stages of the Enrolment Process



Supporting documents

The following documents will be required with your enrolment application upon submission:

1. Birth certificate
2. Immunisation history statement (Medicare issued)
3. Baptism certificate (if applicable)
4. Most recent school reports (at least 2 reports are needed – only for year 1 to year 6 applicants)
5. Documents relating to educational support needed (Pediatrician, Speech Pathology etc.)
6. Visa documentation (if applicable)
